“Forget Me Not” – 2 Kings 21:1-26

1. What makes Manasseh so evil?

2. What is the significance of Manasseh being compared to the Amorites?

3. Does it bother you that Manasseh gets 50+ essentially peaceful years? Does Psalm 49 help bring relief?

4. In what ways might severe affliction lead God’s people to question His goodness. How does Christ’s crucifixion illustrate God’s goodness in the midst of His wrath?

5. What causes you to forget? Does memory shape our identity? What means have we been given to help our memory? How can you work at remembering what the Lord has done?

6. Do you believe that the Lord truly forgets and puts our sins behind Him? (Jer 31:34; Hebrews 8:8-12)

7. If you do, how would this be reflected in how you live? What would that look like? Give examples.

8. Do you believe we live in a time of cultural and religious amnesia? How does this passage speak to that? What is the Church's role in this situation?
