2. What did Paul warn them not to do with this calling (v. 13b)?
  
3. How were the Galatians to use their freedom (v. 13c)?
  
4. How does a Christian fulfill the entire law (v. 14)?
  
5. How were the Galatians acting toward each other (v. 15a)?
  
6. What would happen if the Galatians continued this behavior (v. 15b)?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:

7. What does Paul mean by the word “flesh” (v. 13b)?
  
8. What are some ways that Christians provide a “beachhead” or a “staging ground” for the flesh?
  
9. In what way(s) have you been allowing your flesh opportunities to express its desires?
  
10. Why is love so connected to genuine service?
  
11. Can one serve without having love?
  
12. How does love fulfill the Law?

13. Give an example of love fulfilling the Law.
14. What is the world's view of love?
15. Can people apart from Christ love others?
16. How can Christians disagree in love? What would this look like?
17. What are ways that Christians disturb the purity and peace of the Church?
18. Is love consistent with opposing someone or something? Why or why not?
19. How can an individual member of the church promote purity and peace in the church if he has no official role in the congregation?
20. If you live continually disobedient to Christ and His Word, how can other Christians best show their love to you?
