SERMON NOTES

Title: “Ratification of the Gracious Sinai Covenant” (Part 2)  
Text: Exodus 24:1-18  
Theme: When the gracious Sinai covenant was ratified, God brought an entire nation close to Him. Today, the outward circumstances have changed, but God’s covenant still brings all who profess Christ Jesus near to Him to live forever. This means that entrance into God’s covenant is not the end, it’s the beginning! It is YOUR beginning when you profess Christ Jesus as your Lord and Savior.

- A. The Lord’s Instructions to Moses for Approaching Him (1-2)
  - B. Moses Mediates the Ratification of the Covenant with the People (3-8)

III. Applications

- A. The role and ministry of the \_\_\_\_\_ is not superfluous or ceremonial but \_\_\_\_\_ for the well-being of the Church. They must be those who have “\_\_\_\_\_” God (been born of the Spirit) and fellowship with Him in their own \_\_\_\_\_ lives.
