Questions for Younger Ones (ages 5-18) to Answer from the Text:

1. What bad things are Christians to rid from their lives (2:1)?
2. What do these negative things mean?
3. What does Peter compare Christians to as they grow (2:2a)?
4. What should Christians deeply desire (2:2a)?
5. What results when Christians desire and receive this nourishment (2:3c)?
6. Why should Christians long for this (2:3)?

Questions for Reflection and Discussion:
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7. What does it mean to “take in” the Word of God?
8. When you know the truth, what is the result?
9. How is it possible that some people can know much about Scripture but either do not believe it, or do not live according to God’s Word?
10. How does knowing Scripture enable you to grow spiritually?
11. How can a like-minded companion help you grow deeper in Christ?
12. Besides reading God’s Word, what else helps and enables you to grow spiritually?
13. How does understanding more about the plan of redemption enable you to grow more spiritually mature?
14. According to the sermon, what is one of the fastest ways to experience spiritual growth?
